

JUNIOR HOUSE FOURS.

These races were rowed instead of The Bumps on June 22, 23 and 24, and won somewhat easily by Crescent. The winners, who originally were Crescent II but proved themselves faster than their first crew and were exchanged for them, rowed long and hard. They were well stroked by True who gave his crew a good length and did not try to row too fast a stroke. The other three members of the crew, who joined the Boat Club this term for the first time, showed what can be done by careful coaching and regular practice. St. Peter's, although much heavier than the winners, were considerably shorter, and at the end of the course appeared to be carrying more than one passenger. Spankie rowed hard and well. Hutton stroked Cuthbert's fairly well for the first part of the course but his crew altogether failed to last: their steering was disappointing. Paulo never appeared to be trying to race. Woolley set his crew a slow paddling stroke and seemed quite content to be several lengths behind. Bromham and Ashburnham were not remarkable in any way.
